The Jazz Orchestra of the Concertgebouw (JOC) is known as the best and most swinging big band in the Netherlands. The orchestra was, among others, founded by Henk Meutgeert in 1996 as the New Concert Big Band and upon request of the Concertgebouw, it changed its name into Jazz Orchestra of the Concertgebouw.

The JOC performs with some of the big names in the business like Benny Golson, Oleta Adams, Caro Emerald, Georgie Fame and young talent like José James and Christian Scott. It brings Dutch jazz to a worldwide audience. Every year, some 35,000 visitors attend the JOC concerts. Dennis Mackrel was recently introduced as new the chief conductor.
